



Carnegie Hall Performance/New York City Trip Double Occupancy Contract

Please read the following information carefully before signing. By signing this contract, you will be obligated to pay the entire amount of the trip regardless of whether you or your child attends. Trip dates are March 27 through 30, 2024.

Deposit and Payment Information

The total cost of the trip is \$2371. A \$771.00 deposit is required of each participant at the time this contract is signed. Students and chaperones will not be reserved a space on the trip unless this signed contract and the \$771.00 deposit is received by September 15, 2023. The \$771.00 deposit will be applied to your total account, and is non-refundable. In the event that we must make cuts because of excessive numbers, refunds will be issued to those that have been cut from the trip.

The following payment schedule must be followed, as the band is bound by deadlines set by the tour company. Payments will be due by the date listed below. This schedule applies to students and chaperones.

Trip Package Information

Trip includes the following:

- 3 nights hotel accommodations at the Sheraton New York Hotel

The package price DOES NOT cover the cost of meals other than the dinner cruise, personal items, souvenirs, optional activities, or anything not specifically mentioned above. Students will be responsible for the cost of these items. We estimate \$50.00 per day for food.

Refund Policy

No refunds of any kind will be issued from the St. Amant Bands to any individual who chooses not to participate in the trip after this contract is signed. Additionally, no refund will be issued to individuals who move, transfer, drop band, or are unable to attend the trip due to circumstances beyond the control of the St. Amant Band, or students who are prohibited from school-sponsored events in accordance with Ascension Parish School Board or St. Amant High School Administrative policy.

Liability

Students and chaperones are responsible for their own belongings for the duration of the trip. Loss, damage, or theft of personal property will be at the expense of the individual. This includes luggage, clothing, personal effects, musical instruments, cash, traveler’s checks, credit cards, audio/video equipment, cameras, and all other personal property.

Any damages to the hotel rooms, tour buses, or other property will be the responsibility of the student(s)/chaperones(s) involved. The Ascension Parish School Board, St. Amant High School, and St. Amant High School Band and Band Boosters are NOT responsible for payment of damages caused by anyone.

The Ascension Parish School Board, St. Amant High School, and St. Amant High School Band and Band Boosters are NOT responsible for parents and children attending this trip separate from the band.

General Guidelines

Any trip with the band is considered an Academic Commitment. As with any school activity, all school rules are in effect. Any student found in violation will be dealt with according to Ascension Parish School Board, St. Amant High School, and St. Amant High Band policy. In severe cases, including the possession or consumption of alcohol or illegal drugs, inappropriate student contact, vandalism, illegal activity, or any other serious offense, the offending student(s) will forfeit the remainder of his/her trip, and must have a parent or guardian transport them home immediately. The offending students will then be referred to the school administration upon returning to school, and will be dealt with according to school board policy. Other forms of discipline may be made at the discretion of the band directors including, but not limited to, prohibition from selected activities, work detail, or other appropriate actions.

Prior to the trip, a bus list and rooming list will be posted for students to sign. The seats and rooms signed for will be the ones assigned those students and will not be changed. The band directors will have the option to change room/bus assignments in order to eliminate discipline and/or accommodation problems. Prior to leaving, all student luggage, bags, and personal items will be thoroughly searched for illegal/prohibited items.
